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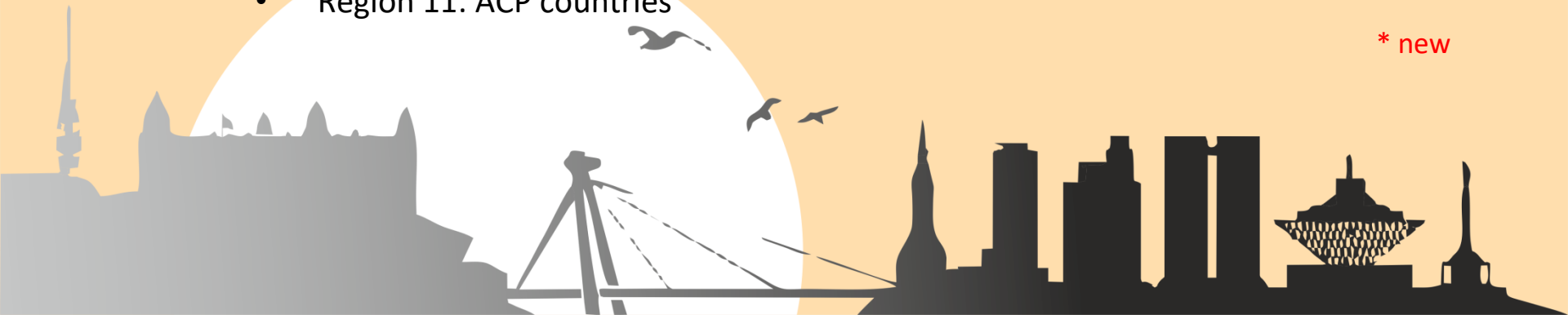


# Capacity Building in Higher Education

## Eligible Countries

- 34 Programme Countries: EU28, FL, IS, NO, MK, RS, TR
- about 150 Partner Countries:
  - Region 1: Western Balkans
  - Region 2: Eastern Partnership countries
  - Region 3: South-Mediterranean countries
  - Region 4: Territory of Russia
  - Region 6: Asia (not the industrialised countries!)
  - Region 7: Central Asia
  - Region 8: Latin America (out: Chile & Uruguay)
  - Region 9: Middle East
  - Region 10: South Africa
  - Region 11: ACP countries

# Capacity Building in Higher Education

## Objectives

- improve the **quality of higher education** and enhance its **relevance** for the **labour market** and **society**
- improve the level of **competences** and **skills** in HEIs by developing new and **innovative education programmes**
- enhance the **management, governance** and **innovation capacities**, as well as the **internationalisation** of HEIs
- increase the capacities of **national authorities** to modernise their **higher education systems**, by supporting to the definition, implementation and monitoring of **reform policies**
- foster **regional integration** and **cooperation** across different regions of the world through joint initiatives, sharing of good practices and cooperation



# Capacity Building in Higher Education

## Consortium

- Coordinator must be a Higher Education Institution (HEI) and can come from almost all eligible country
- at least 2 HEIs from 2 different Programme Countries
- HEI from Partner Countries  $\geq$  HEI from Programme Countries!!!  
but at least 2 HEI from each Partner Country
- Structural Projects: relevant authority of each targeted Partner Country has to be part
- positive for the project: invite companies & businesses, NGOs, students associations, ...



# Capacity Building in Higher Education

## Project Types

- **Joint Projects (JP):** focus on the institutional level in the Higher Education
    - modernisation of curriculum by developing innovative courses and methodologies
    - modernisation of governance, management and functioning of higher education
    - strengthening of relations between higher education and the wider economic and social environment
  - **Structural Projects (SP):** focus on the level of the Higher Education systems
    - modernisation of governance, management and functioning of higher education
    - strengthening of relations between higher education and the wider economic and social environment
- + relevant authority of each targeted Partner Country must be involved!

# Capacity Building in Higher Education

## Duration & Budget & *Deadline (tbc)*

2 or 3 years and € 500.000 – € 1 Mio. / project

<b>Staff costs (max. 40%)</b> Unit costs	manager; researcher/teacher/trainer; technician; administrative staff
<b>Travel costs</b> Unit costs	travel to the countries involved
<b>Costs of stay</b> Unit costs	costs of subsistence, accommodation health insurance,...
<b>Equipment (max. 30%)</b> Real costs	for HEIs in Partner Countries only
<b>Sub-contracting (max. 10%)</b> Real costs	for competencies which cannot be covered by the consortium, e.g. financial audit, external QA

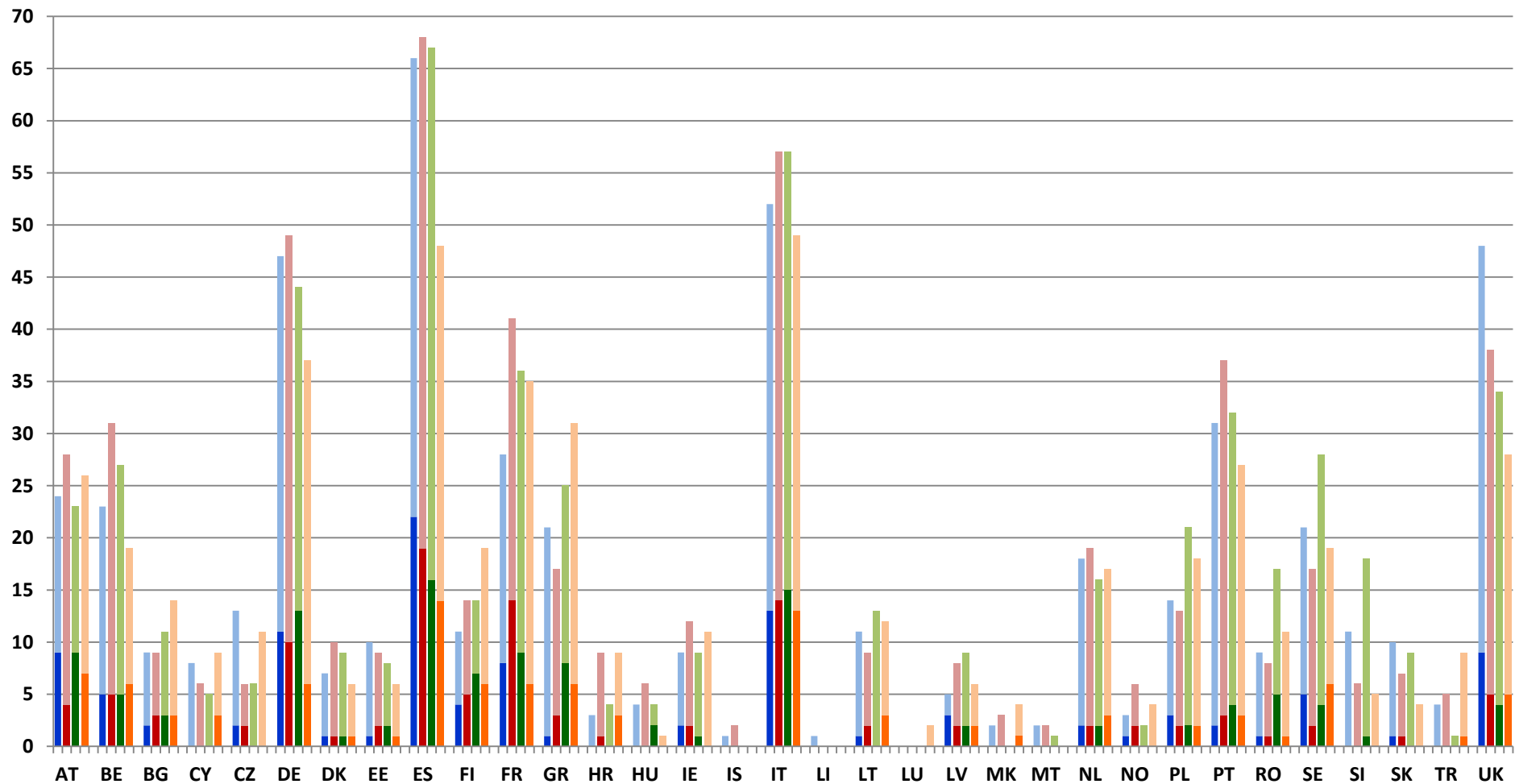

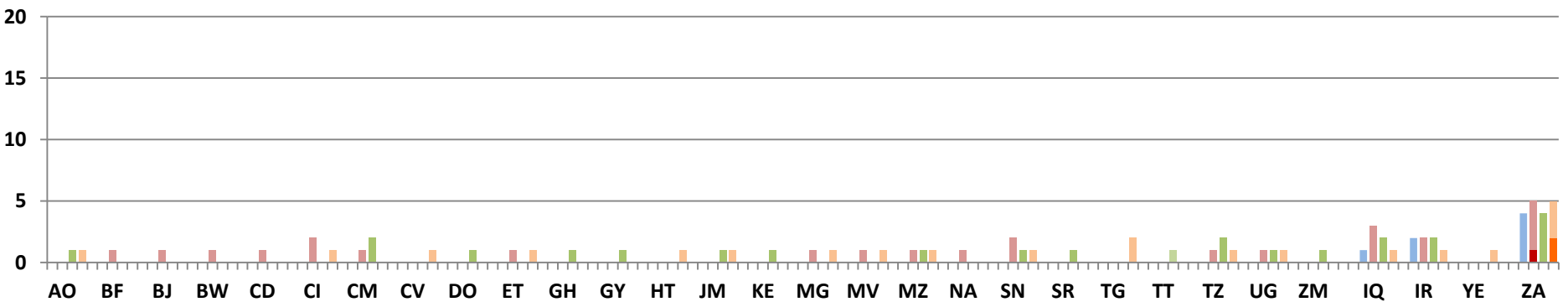
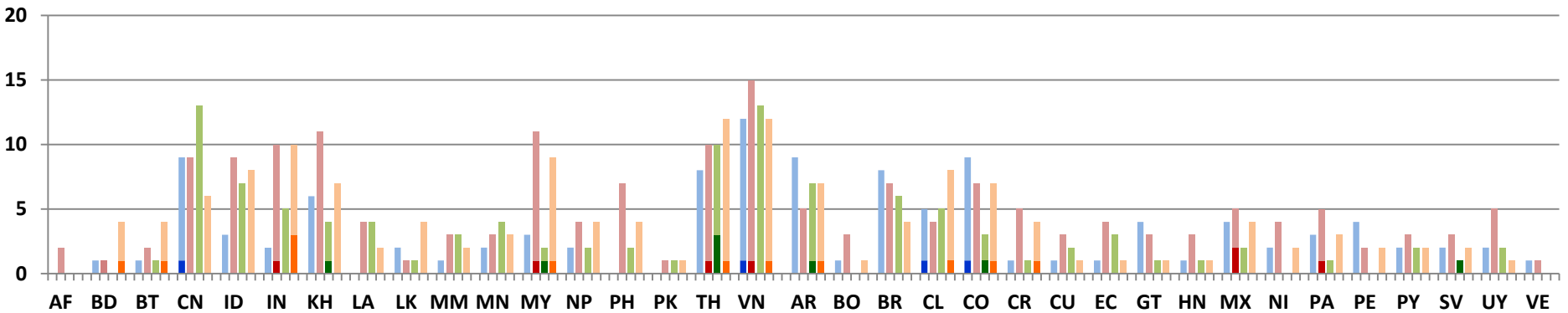
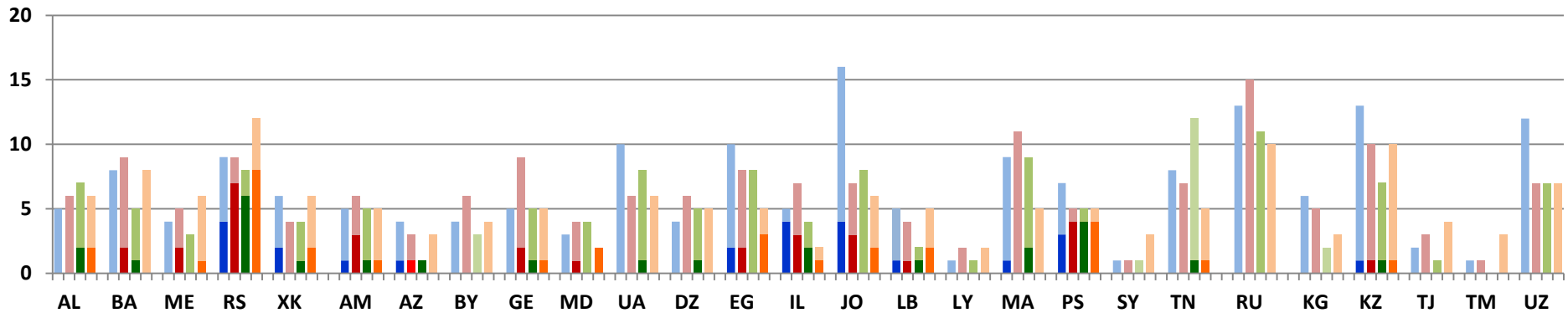
# CBHE 2015 - 2018 – Programme Countries

- 2015: in total: 515 applications → 452 eligible projects → 138 selected projects (= 26,80%)
- 2016: in total: 736 applications → 653 eligible projects → 147 selected projects (= 19,97%)
- 2017: in total: 833 applications → 756 eligible projects → 149 selected projects (= 17,89%)
- 2018: in total: 887 applications → 874 eligible projects → 147 selected projects (= 16,82%)
