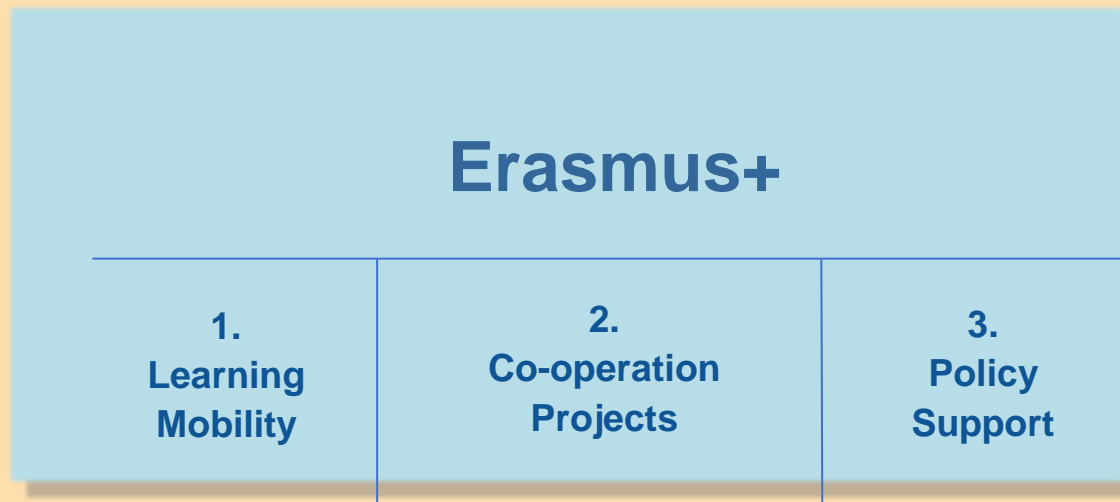

A single integrated programme



Specific activities:

Jean Monnet - Objectives

Promote teaching and research on European integration

Support activities of academic institutions or associations

Promote policy debate and exchange between the academic world and policy-makers

Diversifying EU-related subjects in all curricula, less used disciplines

Promoting participation of young academics

Involving civil society representatives



Jean Monnet – How does it work?

Action grants to promote excellence through:

- Teaching and research (Modules, Chairs, Centres of Excellence)
- Policy debate with academic world (Networks, Projects)
- Support to activities of Associations



Teaching and research in the field of EU studies

MODULES

Min 40 teaching hours/year, 3-year grants, max grant: € 30.000

CHAIRS

Chair Holder: Min 90 teaching hours/year + at least 1 additional activity /year, 3-year grants, max grant: € 50.000

CENTRES OF EXCELLENCE

Focal points of competence and knowledge, 3-year grants, max grant: € 100.000

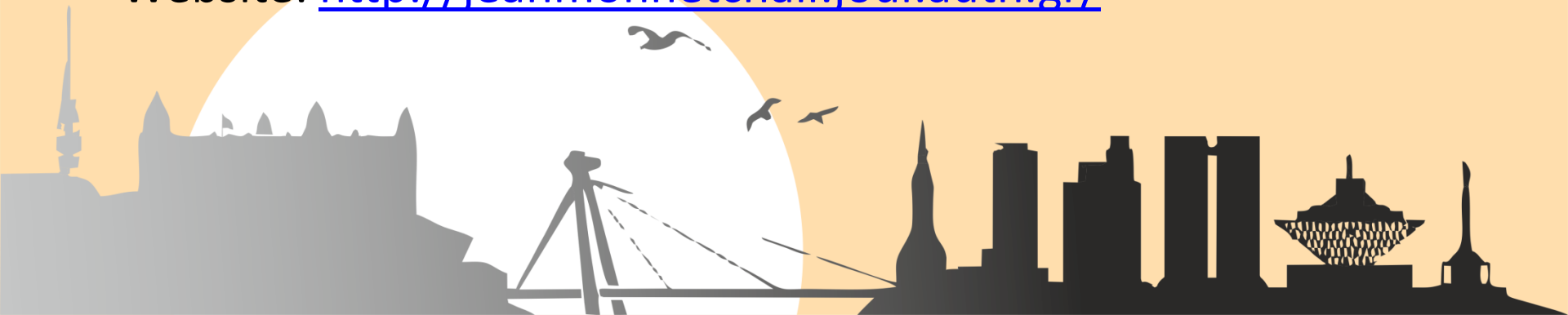
European Integration Journalism

Duration: 2015-2018

Participants: students from different disciplines, researchers, civil servants, organised civil society and general public at large

Policy debate and exchanges

NETWORKS:

foster creation, development of consortia of international players (HEIs, Centres of Excellence, departments, etc.) in area of EU studies

Involvement minimum 3 partner institutions from 3 different countries, 3-year grants, max grant: € 300.000

PROJECTS:

support innovation, cross-fertilisation, spread of EU content, involvement of other partners possible, duration 12 – 18 - 24 months, max grant: € 60.000

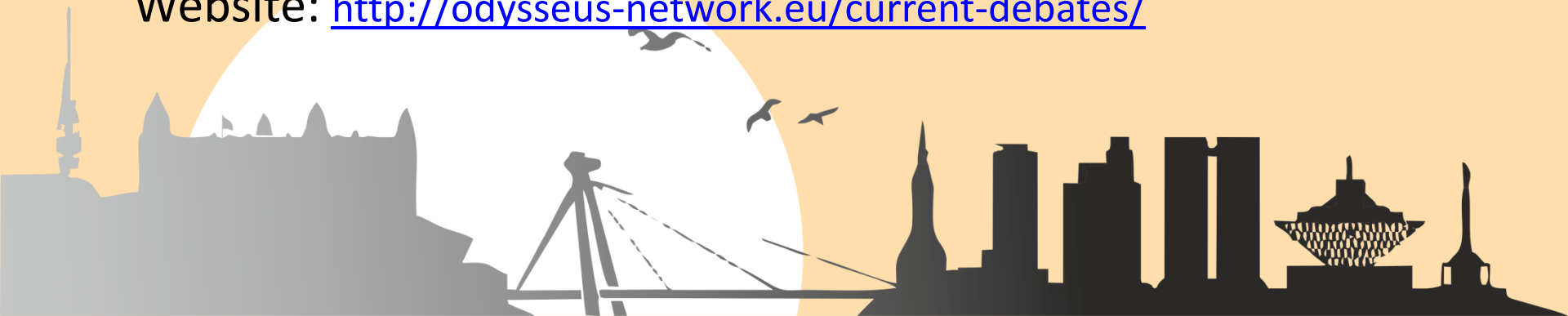
ODYSSEUS-MONNET NETWORK ON IMMIGRATION AND ASYLUM

Duration: 2015-2018

Support to Associations

Support to Associations:

contribute to the study of the EU integration process, interdisciplinary approach, officially registered and independent; open to all interested professors, teachers and researchers specialising in EU issues, at regional, national or supranational level;

3-year grants, max grant: € 50.000

Communicating the EU in Ireland

Duration: 2015 – 2018

Participants: multi-disciplinary association of scholars and practitioners, representatives of Irish universities and civil society, north and south in Ireland.

Max. community grants (of total budget): 75% - 80%

Jean Monnet Selection Results 2018

Budget available: 15,5 mio. EUR total

- 12 million **Jean Monnet budget**
- 3.5 million **Partnership Instrument budget** (Australia, China, Hong Kong SAR, India, Indonesia, Iran, Macao, Mexico, New Zealand, Russia, South Africa, Taiwan, United States of America)

Applications received: 1 255

Projects selected: 232 in total (180 + 52)

Success rate: 18 %

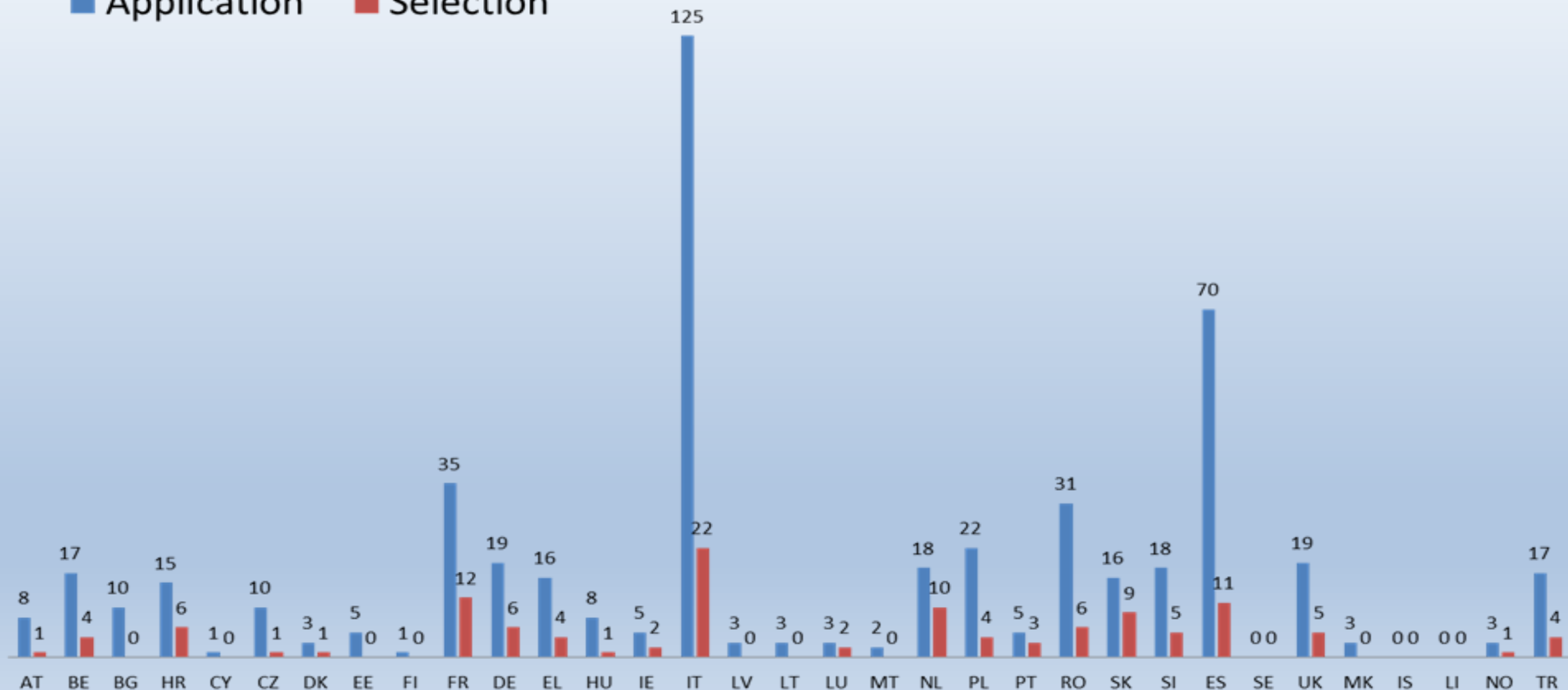
Award criteria: Relevance of the proposal / Quality of the project design and implementation / Quality of the project team / Impact and dissemination

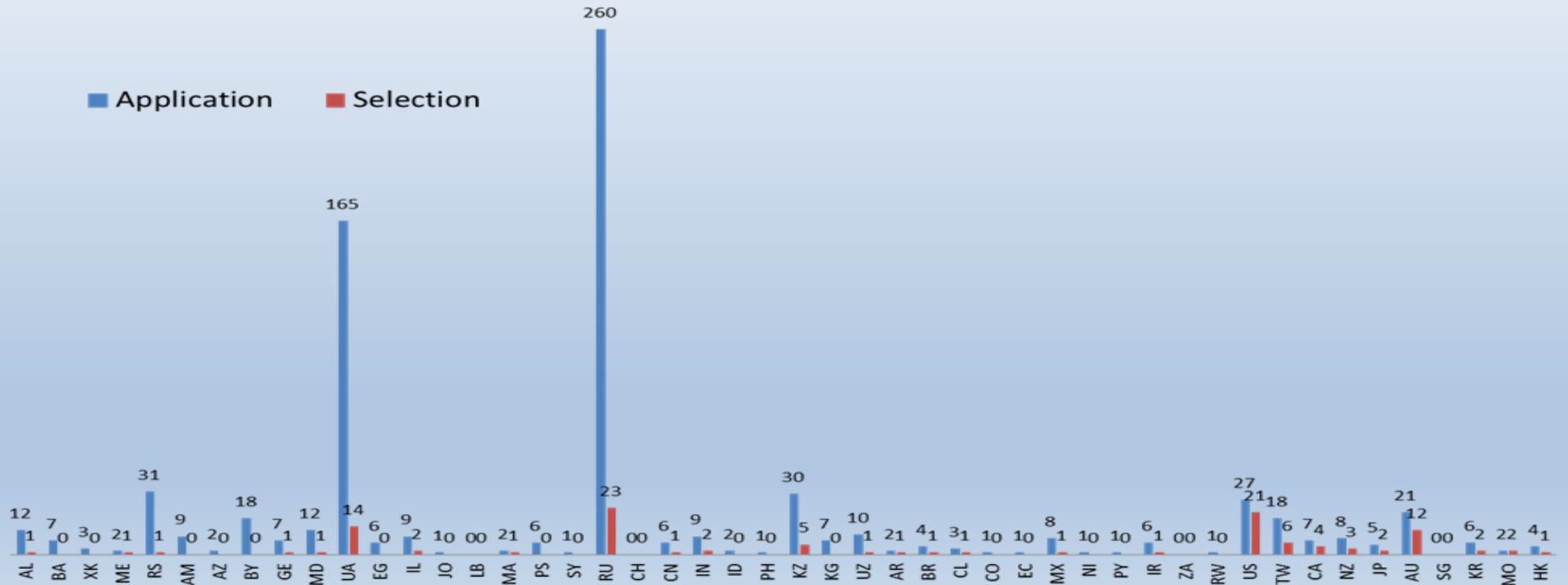
Programme Countries 2018

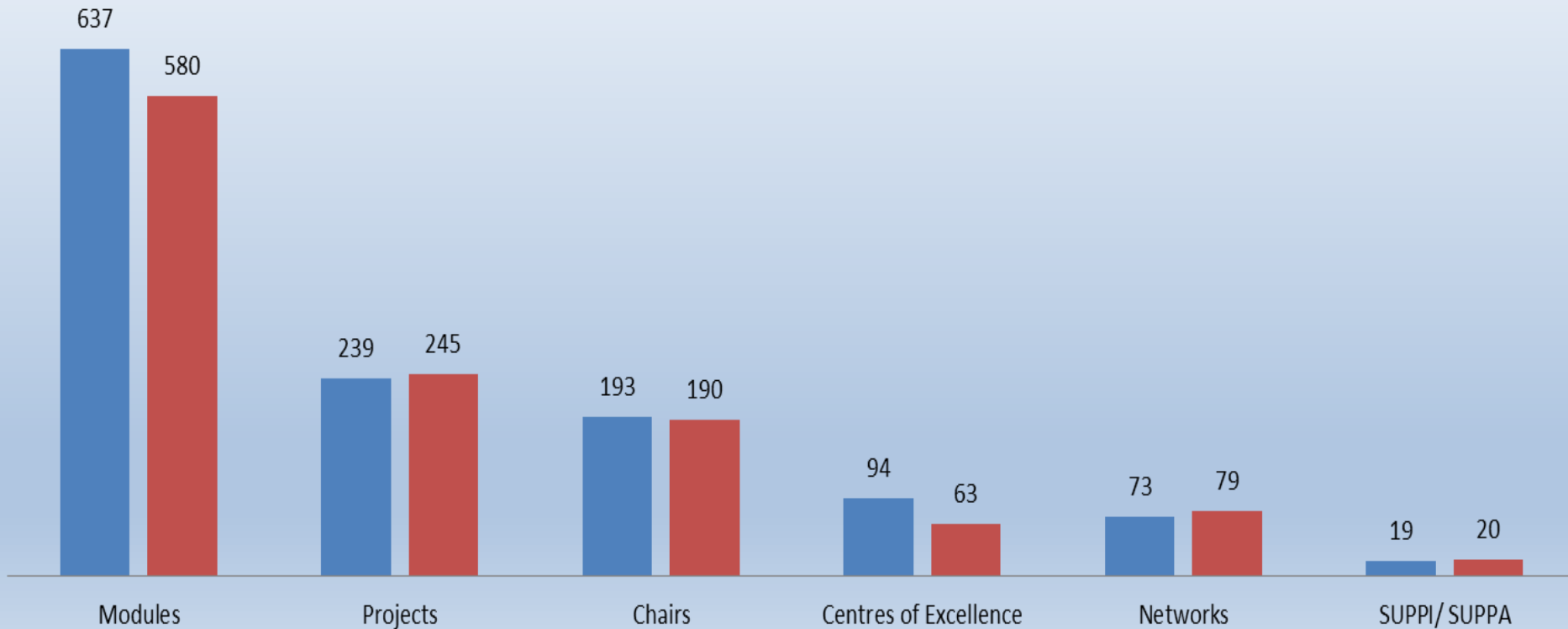
Partner Countries 2018

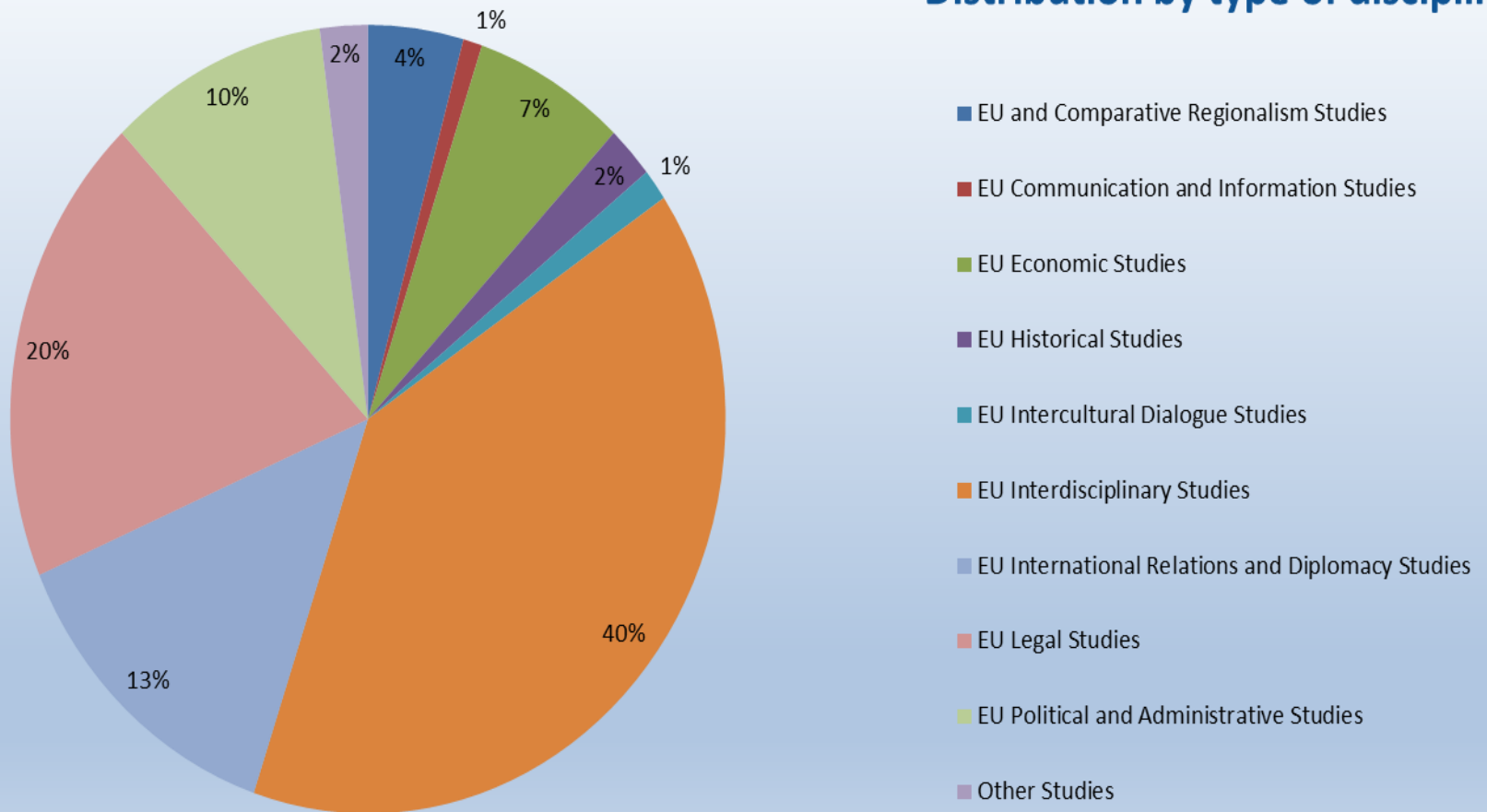
Distribution by type of activities

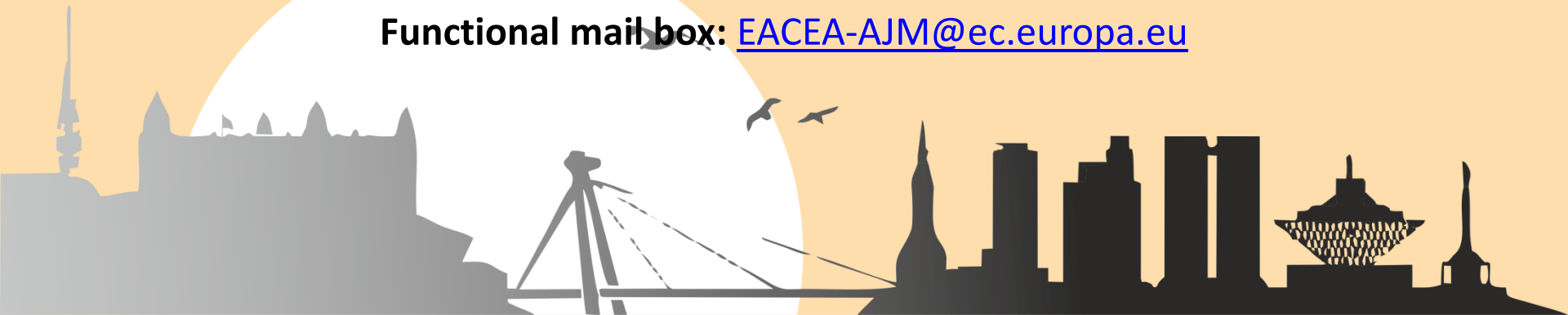
