Associated partner


- contributes to the implementation of specific tasks/activities

Affiliated partner

- · contributes to the achievement of project objectives and activities
- must be identified in the grant application

Duration and budget

- 2 year project max. funding 700 000 EUR
- 3 year project max. funding 1 000 000 EUR
- budget on basis of unit cost system
