Other partners: public or private organisations in the field of education, research or inovation from programme countries.





Centralized activities can be keystones / building blocks for activies within alliances.



Pilot phase 2019 and 2020

- 2 pilot calls
- Support of 4 6 alliances for 3 years / per call
- Part of KA2 centralized action (EACEA)
- 2 selection rounds
 - Award criteria
 - "Political selection" round
- Support variety of alliances (research universities / college type HEIs)
- 5 million EUR per alliance
- Call 2019 deadline: 28 February 2019 (Check the official call!)
