Introduction

What is the Central European Joint Infoday?

The Central European Joint Infoday is a joint event organised by the Slovak, Austrian and Hungarian Erasmus+ National Agencies. It is a follow-up activity to yearlong cooperation among the former Erasmus Mundus National Structures in these countries under the former Erasmus Mundus programme. The main focus of the infoday is centralised actions of the Erasmus+ programme where the cooperation between higher education institutions from programme countries and partner countries is strongly supported, i.e. Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees, Capacity Building in Higher Education, Jean Monnet. Knowledge Alliances are also included as a centralised action in the higher education sector.

What are the aims of the event?

The main aim of the Central European Joint Infoday is to increase the visibility of the Erasmus+ programme and its international dimension as supported by the centralised actions. The event has been promoted to higher education institutions in the three organising countries of Slovakia, Austria and Hungary, neighbouring countries of the Czech Republic and Poland, as well as Croatia. Partner countries of Israel, Kazakhstan, Palestine and Serbia have accepted the invitation to actively participate, too. The international setting of the infoday enhances its networking potential. That's why participants do not only learn how to submit a successful proposal under the 2016 call for proposals, but they also have the opportunity to meet other project coordinators and find new project partners.

Who are the participants?

Participants of the seminar are representatives of academia coming from 10 different countries: Austria, Croatia, the Czech Republic, Hungary, Israel, Kazakhstan, Palestine, Poland, Serbia and Slovakia. Representatives of the EACEA Executive Agency in Brussels are also present and contribute to the event with several presentations.

Development and advancement of applied methodology for assessing and matching the competences developed at three universities in Ukraine and those required by the labour market. Most of the basic concept of this project is transferred from the Tempus project CUP. The main aim of COMPETE is to allow Ukrainian Universities to develop their curricula and syllabi on up to date procedures and processes, akin to EU universities according to the Bologna principle. This enables them to participate in student exchange programs and to provide a means for adapting university curricula to the needs of the labour market in order to boost regional economic development and to enhance the employability of their graduates.

Given the increased impact of EU law on almost all aspects of life and an increasing number of EU legal provisions referring to "ethics" and / or "morality", there is a need for deepening both **teaching** and **research** on **European integration and ethics**. Therefore, this project, will promote both excellence of teaching (comprehensive concept of courses on European integration and ethics), and conducting (additional) research in a new area of EU integration, where both areas (i.e. teaching and research) will mutually benefit from each other.

This project develops in-depth **teaching** on and raising awareness for EU integration and ethics for future professionals, an offer missing so far. Beyond just raising awareness and fostering critical thinking, this project aims at enhancing students' **employability**, by also including very practical topics (such as triple bottom line, non-financial reporting etc.). Upon successful participation, students will be awarded a certificate. Links to partners (Rotterdam, Sheffield etc.) and an international advisory board will both contribute to the quality of the project and dissemination of results. For both teaching and dissemination, new (teaching) technologies already tested at our institution (Adobe Connect, etc.) will be employed.

This project is **embedded** into MCI's **mission** (including UN Global Compact, Prime Initiative, etc.), **coordinated** with courses of colleagues and aims at **further stimulation** of the topic, both within MCI and beyond.

The capacity building projects aims at building capacity in the field of **international dispute resolution** on two levels: **student's level** (expert lectures, workshops, summer schools and moot courts) and **practitioner's level** (lawyers and judges; workshops and conferences). The idea for this project evolved from the curriculum development of a postgraduate Master of Laws degree in International Dispute Resolution that was devised together with Dr. Christian Konrad, founding partner of the international arbitration law firm Konrad & Partners. The particularity of the LL.M. program is that international experts are invited to serve as guest lecturers and the know-how of the various jurisdictions is therefore streamlined in one educational program at Danube University Krems. This informal network with the most qualified academics and practitioners of the field lead to the idea to institutionalize and disseminate this concept throughout the CEE region and specifically **to build up capacity in the EU's partner countries (Georgia and Moldova).**

EMJMD: The joint master's in Regenerative Medicine is a high-level integrated international study programme of 120 ECTS credits (2 year full time). The consortium currently consists of Danube University Krems – the coordinating institution, Semmelweis University Budapest, the University of Turin, and the Weizmann Institute of Technology, Rehovot/Israel. The target audience is multi-fold: new and experienced researchers in the adult stem cell therapy field, students (graduate and post-doctoral) and physicians. Graduates with degrees in biological sciences or medicine will gain an in-depth understanding of the cellular and molecular aspects of regenerative medicine as well as an introduction to the interdisciplinary fields of biomaterials and tissue engineering. Similarly, students with a physical sciences background will have the opportunity to broaden their experiences and acquire new skills in the biological sciences.

One aspect of the programme is to enchance the profile and image of European higher education worldwide. In this presentation, I would like to introduce the successive MEMooc project of the University of Miskolc (Miskolci Egyetem), Hungary that can help "the promotion of the European Union as a centre of excellence in learning around the world".

MEMooc stands for Miskolci Egyetem Massive Open Online Courses (www.memooc.hu) and offers 52 courses – both in English and in Hungarian - connected to the Information Engineering programme at BSc level. The courses were developed at the EDX platform within a cooperation of multiple higher education institutions of Hungary under the leadership of the University of Miskolc and can be divided into two main categories: 12 of the courses belong to the group of full-time basic courses, while 40 of them are supplementary practical courses.

Full-time basic courses are those that provide fundamental theoretical and practical knowledge an Information Engineer should have at BSc level. These courses were developed on the basis of the full-time Information Engineering BSc programme accredited in Hungary and include: Information and Communications Technologies, Systematic Approach to IT Systems, Database Systems and Applications, Basics of Programming Languages, Object-Oriented Programming, Application Development and Administration, Computer Network Design, Server Administration, Web Programming, Development of Multimedia Content and Mobile Programming.

The group of supplementary courses covers a wide range of optional practice-oriented courses that supplement fundamental courses with practical problems and their solutions. These courses are also good for orienting students towards some specialized areas of Information Engineering. At present this group involves, among others, some courses related to Java programming and Web technologies; operating system and database system administration; computer networks and security; data structures and algorithms; numeric methods, optimization and mathematics for informatics; computer graphics; logistics; robotics; artificial intelligence; digital image and speech processing; computer aided production planning and control.

The MEMooc project started in Spring 2015 and the official site was launched in November 2015 after the completion of some performance tests. It is on the fly now and we can present a report on the achievements of more than 200 students.

The success of the MEMooc project encourages the University of Miskolc to move on in this direction. We would like to extend the offered courses to MSc level on the basis of our Information Engineering MSc programme. We search for cooperation partners and we are also interested in being involved in an Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degrees Project.

Project description

The official educational system, acting on the basis of the law, often uses bureaucratic procedures that can feel threatening and hostile to families who lack the appropriate tools for coping. Because each child has a right to education, an absurd situation is created in which fulfilling that right becomes a threatening obligation.

The Shaveh Center at Oranim College is intended to serve as a mediator in such situations. The staff of the centre, including lecturers from Oranim College who are experts in the relevant fields of social science and knowledgeable about different aspects of educational administration, will instruct students. They will train the students to serve as mediators between parents from excluded groups and the relevant municipal parties, and to give the parents explanations that will make the process easier.

Students will gain understanding of the formal processes and the challenges that these processes pose for people from different cultures. With the guidance of advisors, students will develop tools that translate, simplify, and clarify the processes, and explain why they are necessary and what they can be expected to accomplish. In so doing, multiculturalism and social responsibility will be strengthened as key aspects of teacher training in higher education.

The proposed project is for advancing the academic training of senior position holders in education, who are graduate students at Oranim in the programs of Guidance and Counselling and Inclusive Education. Oranim's fundamental approach is that training educators should take place within its social and communal context. As part of this approach, this project aims to train educators who are intelligent, assertive, and socially responsible. This project will be offered to students as a practical, project-based program in the context of their studies. Outside funding will enable the project to be run without depending on funding from partial parties.

This project will have particular importance for: placement in special education, disciplinary action in schools, truancy prevention, and other related areas. We propose that the project take place in the municipalities that adopt it, in cooperation with the departments of education in those municipalities.

Jean Monnet Chair - Migration

Migration has become a big and constantly growing phenomenon in the last years. We have to stress here that it is necessary to focus interdisciplinary on such a complex term as migration to be able to comprehend it. In the last years research dominated which were limited to a small number of disciplines such as anthropology, sociology, social geography, economics or law, later they were joined by disciplines such as political science and history. Second, research was carried out in a considerable isolation in the last years, or complex interdisciplinary research was rare, not speaking about interdisciplinary research projects or study programmes. We expect at least 6 subjects to be innovated (migration and migration policy; current issues of the European Union development; security in international relations; law of the European Union; public opinion in the EU) and the principal subject of migration and migration policy to be connected with the scientific and research practice.

From the point of view of the basic indicators of success of the submitted project in the context of the set goals, we reckon on:

- learning activities (formal and non-formal): students will have necessary skills and knowledge to succeed in specific employment or they will be able to transfer their skills and knowledge to other university degrees or programmes which are more specialised in the field of migration and migration policies;
- teaching activities: improving instruction, standards of academic excellence. The main instructions are available in multiple and innovative channels of delivery;
- external partners: building and maintaining partnerships supporting formal / non-formal learning and respond to the community needs, including future ongoing cooperation after the end of the project;
- resources: the strengthening of the organisational capacity of the working team, including the allocation of resources (people, facilities, equipment).
