- transnational and result-driven activities between:

Who can participate?

- HEIs and businesses from Programme countries:
 - EU countries
 - IS, LI, NO, MK, RS, TR
- any Partner country as a partner if they bring added value





Role of participants



Applicant/coordinator

- submits project on behalf of all partners
- bears responsibility and coordinates partners



Full partner

- actively contributes to the achievment of objectives
- signs mandate with coordinating organization



Associated partner

- contributes to the implementation of specific tasks/activities
- does not receive funding



Affiliated partner

- contributes to the achievement of project objectives and activities
- must be identified in the grant application






Eligible participants

- any **public or private organisation**, with its affiliated entities (if any), for example:
- √ a higher education institution
- ✓ a public or private, small, medium or large enterprise (including social enterprises).
- √ a research institute
- ✓ a public body at local, regional or national level
- ✓ an organisation active in the field of education, training and youth
- ✓ an intermediary or **association** which represents **education**, training or youth organisations
- ✓ an intermediary or association which represents enterprises
- ✓ an accreditation, certification or qualification body



Partnership requirements



Duration and budget

- 2 year project max. funding 700 000 EUR
- 3 year project max. funding 1 000 000 EUR
- budget on basis of unit cost system
 - to cover project management, project meetings, intellectual outputs (e. g. study programmes, modules, pedagogical materials), dissemination material and events etc.
 - separate unit staff costs groups of countries / 4 distinct personnel categories (manager, teacher, technician, administrative staff)

 - Declaration of honour

Proposal assessment

Relevance of the proposal (maximum 25 points)

Quality of the project design and implementation (maximum 25 points)

- -purpose
- -consistency
- -innovation
- -European added value
- -coherence
- -management
- -structure
- -quality and financial control





Proposal assessment

Quality of the project team and the cooperation arrangements (maximum 30 points)

Impact and dissemination (maximum 20 points)

- -configuration
- -commitment
- -partnership/collaboration/team spirit
- -involvment of partner countries (if any)
- -dissemination
- -impact
- -open access
- -sustainability





Minimum requirements for funding

- 70 points together
 - √ 13 points for the first category
 - √ 13 points for the second category
 - √ 16 points for the third category
 - √ 11 points for the last category
